10. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

King George Hostel has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

it is a rare example of a once common mixture of retail space and accommodation for single workers no longer found in Western Australian country towns;

the building occupies an important corner location in the town and makes a strong contribution to the Austral Terrace streetscape, as well as the character of Katanning;

the building is a good example of a typical Australian corner hotel form, designed in a simplified Federation Queen Anne Revival style; and,

the building has a long association with the Piesse family, who are remembered for their development of Katanning and the surrounding farming district.
