10. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Old Council Offices, a single storey brick and iron building in the Federation Free Style has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the presence of the place contributes towards, and forms part of, a historic group of buildings at the junction of Mends Street, Mill Point Road and Labouchere Road;

the place has associations with the development of the suburb of South Perth and reflects the attitudes of the period when Road Board Offices were a public expression of civic pride; the place has associations with the adjacent Old Mill Theatre (formerly Mechanics Institute, 1899), both of which represent the development of the local government in South Perth; and,

the place has social significance for the residents of South Perth who wished the building to be returned to the rate payers for their use as a repository for heritage records and research.

The toilet block on the eastern side of the building is considered to have little cultural heritage significance.
