## 10. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

*CBH Grain Silos* has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

it is the first advance storage and mechanical bulk grain handling facility constructed in Western Australia;

a dominant structure on the city skyline, the place has a landmark quality; and,

the place is representative of Western Australia's bulk grain handling facilities which contribute to the efficient exportation of grain, an important facet in the State's economy.
