10. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Terrace of Six Houses at 19-29 Holdsworth Street, comprising single storey brick and iron row houses, has cultural heritage significance as a housing group for the following reasons:

the group, together with *Warders Terrace* (1897) and *Seven Terrace Houses* (1898), demonstrates the development of residential areas of Fremantle associated with the State's gold boom and the construction of the Inner Harbour deep water port in the late 1890s;

the group, together with *Warders Terrace* (1897) and *Seven Terrace Houses* (1898), exhibits characteristics of the Victorian Filigree style and contributes to the aesthetic qualities of the streetscape of Holdsworth Street; and

the place collectively demonstrates the standard of residential accommodation built for workers in 1903, and the subsequent changes in ownership illustrate the social mobility of the Fremantle migrant population.
