10. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

York Hotel has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

it is a fine and rare example of Federation Anglo-Dutch architecture with its ensemble of elaborate ornamentation;

the building is an imposing landmark in the Hannan Street Precinct;

it contributes to the streetscape with its verandah as a continuation of a dominant streetscape element;

the hotel's opulence is representative of Kalgoorlie's prosperity, resulting from the discovery of gold; and,

it contributes to the community's sense of place.
