10. **STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE**

Atlas Building, a four-storey commercial building clad in Wunderlich's architectural terracotta, has cultural heritage significance for the following reasons:

the place is a fine and intact example of an Inter-War Free Classical commercial building of the 1930s with Art Deco decorative themes incorporated throughout the building;

the place is a rare demonstration of Wunderlich architectural terracotta cladding, and exhibits a high quality of architectural detailing and craftsmanship; and,

the place is a rare and representative reminder of the 1920s and 1930s, a period in which few commercial buildings were constructed.
